#### **Guidelines for Candidates**

# **Reporting Times**

- Shift 1:
  - Reporting Time: 7:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.
  - o Gate Closing Time: 8:30 a.m.
- Shift 2:
  - o Reporting Time: 1:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.
  - o Gate Closing Time: 2:30 p.m.

**Note:** After the gate closes, **no candidate will be entertained**.

#### **Prohibited Items**

Candidates are strictly prohibited from bringing the following items into the examination hall:

#### 1. Electronic Devices:

o Calculators, mobile phones, smartwatches, and similar gadgets.

# 2. Personal Belongings:

- o Purses, handbags, earphones, microphones, cameras, tape recorders, etc.
- Metallic items like kara, metal bands, or any type of jewelry (bangles, bracelets, rings, earrings, anklets).

#### 3. Food and Beverages:

o Tea, coffee, chips, or any snackable items are not allowed (except for diabetic candidates).

#### 4. Clothing and Accessories:

- o Clothes with too many pockets, garments with large buttons, scarves, caps, dupattas, or goggles.
- o Footwear with thick soles or any clothing with metallic elements.

#### 5. Other Items:

o Digital or wristwatches, belts, vehicle keys, or any other metallic objects.

#### **Facilities at the Test Centre**

# • Free Baggage Facility

A free baggage facility is available at the test centre. However, it is at the candidate's own risk.

## **Exam Day Guidelines**

There are also important exam day guidelines that candidates should remember and follow. We have listed them out below.

- It is recommended that the candidates must reach the examination centre two hours prior to the start of the test.
- As soon as the examination room opens, the candidates should take their seats. If the candidates fail to report on time for any cause, such as a traffic jam, train or bus delay, etc. will probably miss some crucial instructions that will be announced in the exam room.

- The candidate must show the printed or downloaded admit card. The test centre staff will verify the details on the admit card.
- Each candidate will be given a seat dynamically allotted by System with their Roll Number on it.

  Candidates must locate and sit in the assigned seats only.
- The applicant should make sure the question paper displayed on the computer is the same as the subject specified on the admit card. If the question's topic is something other than his or her chosen subject, the same may be brought to the attention of the relevant Invigilator.
- In case of any technical difficulties, a first aid emergency, or any other details while taking the test the candidates may speak with the Centre Superintendent/Invigilator in the room. If a candidate provides false information and participates in more than one shift or date, his or her candidature will be cancelled, and the results won't be disclosed.
- Under no circumstances re-test will be organised for those who are unable to show up on the scheduled test day for any reason.

By adhering to these guidelines, candidates can ensure a smooth and hassle-free examination experience.
